SOIL	Clay limestone, with subsoil of limestone with entroques and Ostrea acuminata marls
ORIENTATION	South-east
AVERAGE ALTITUDE	280 m
VINIFICATION	30–50% whole bunches; 10–15 days maceration in wooden vats
MATURATION	18–20 months in oak barrels; approx. 45% new barrels
TASTING NOTES	Very deep red robe Nose of black fruits and spices A powerful and complex wine of remarkable length
LAYING DOWN	10 years minimum
