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| GRAPE VARIETY | Pinot Noir |
| ACREAGE | 0.9802 hectare |
| YEAR OF PLANTING | 1912, 1974, 1987 |
| SOIL | Clay limestone |
| ORIENTATION | South-east |
| AVERAGE ALTITUDE | 280 m |
| VINIFICATION | 30–50% whole bunches; 10–15 days maceration in wooden vats |
| MATURATION | 18–20 months in oak barrels; approx. 40% new barrels |
| TASTING NOTES | Deep red robe Nose of black fruits and spices Silky tannins, impressive length and complexity |
| LAYING DOWN | 7/8 years minimum |
